MUFA PROTECTIVE MEASURE POLICY

Madison Ultimate Frisbee Association (<u>MUFA</u>) is fully committed to safeguarding the health and safety of all participants. For this reason, effective immediately, MUFA enacts the following policy applicable to all participants, regardless of position or authority:

Participants shall:

- Maintain six feet physical distancing from others whenever possible.
 - This includes 100% of the time not actively playing on the field. Six feet physical distancing is required on the sidelines, when entering and leaving the playing field or playing location.
 - Maintain at least three feet of physical distancing when marking or stall counting other participants.
- Be required to wear a face covering as outlined in <u>public health orders</u>. Participants are responsible for supplying their own masks, and team captains and coaches are required to ensure that all participants have adequate masks that meet public health guidelines and wear them fully over the mouth and nose at all times.
- Participants are only allowed to lower/remove their mask when distanced on the sideline and actively drinking or
 eating. This unmasked time should never be within 6 feet of other participants, and should always be as brief as
 possible. Those participants who abuse the allowance for mask removal for eating or drinking are subject to removal
 from the league without opportunity for a refund.
- Demonstrate proper use of all personal protective equipment or PPE prior to participating in any MUFA event.
- Maintain physical distancing whenever possible and minimize contact between participants
- Not have any direct person to person contact (i.e., no hand shaking, no high fives, no fist bumps, no hugs)

MUFA shall:

- Require all participants to wear face covering as outlined in public health orders
- Limit number of participants present on the premises at any given time to current order limits
- Have reporting and notification procedures in place for any potential COVID exposure, as well as a complaint procedure for COVID-19 related violations or issues.
